Do you remember how Jesus called Simon and his brother Andrew to be his disciples? ## DID YOU KNOW? About the FireHouse Feedings?

There are many "hidden" ministries at OSLC, activities that people have taken upon themselves to show the compassion of Christ to the needy. If your heart feels drawn to helping, give these secret angels a call or click.

On the second Tuesday of each month, you can usually find Judi (Russell) Case in the OSLC kitchen, often with Dianne Tanner, Georgeanne Park, Marilyn Larson and others, gathering ingredients to prepare a warm and fulfilling meal for the less fortunate in Issaquah.

The ministry is led by Catholic Charities, and OSLC is one of many local churches that have a coordinator who schedules volunteers to help cook and transport the food to the Issaquah Firehouse. Typically there are 30 - 45 people eagerly lined up and waiting, offering smiles, prayers, and lots of praise during this hour of fellowship. Judi keeps track of some of the regulars; she asks how they are doing, balancing the stress of living on the streets with staying clean and drug free. Some backslide; others improve.

Judi finds a wide variety of people there: elderly on fixed incomes; others who are out of work, or underemployed; young moms with little ones to feed; the mentally impaired – but all, she says, are thankful for the encouragement and the hot meals.

"We don't have to put in a lot of time on these meals. Volunteers divide the shopping; preparation only takes an hour or two; then we serve, clean up and depart within 90 minutes! But it is deeply satisfying to know we reach out in some small way to God's children, nourishing and encouraging them."

Here are some interesting statistics on the program itself: the Meals Program served 387 unduplicated residents and 8,530 meals in 2010, averaging 710 meals per month. (This is a 40% increase in number of people served and a 22% increase in number of meals served.) And there is an ever increasing need for this ministry!






