After consuming the elements, place the cup in the trays provided. To indicate that you would like to receive words of blessing instead of bread & wine, simply cross your arms over your chest.

Offerings may be left in the basket on the table at this time.



And they shall live secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth; ^{5a}and he shall be the one of peace.

he ascended into heaven


and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.


