

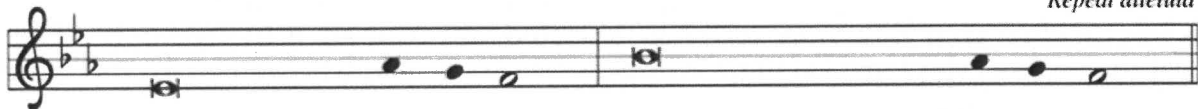

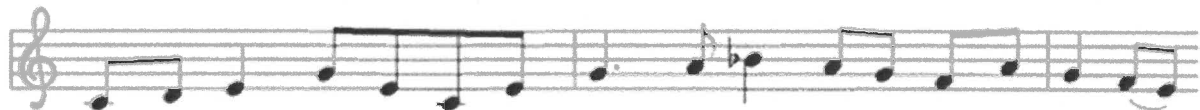

Ignore and Delete Scam Emails

Recently, many have received emails that appear to be from Pr. Kristin-Luana or Cynthia, asking for a favor or to run an urgent errand; the subject line may be "God bless you (your name)." If you look closely, you'll see these emails have errors and awkward wording. **We didn't send these emails. Be aware that the pastors and staff will never email, text, or call to ask for a favor or gift cards.**

Don't reply to these scam emails. A cybercriminal is trying to lure you to reply and buy gift cards. They're targeting many churches, knowing that good-hearted people may respond to a "pastor's" or "staff's" plea for help. Please don't fall for it, and quickly delete these junk emails.

To tighten up security, Joan F. has removed email addresses from the OSLC website—since that's likely where the cybercriminal harvested them. From now on, we'll avoid publishing email addresses and not list full names on the prayer list. Only the office email will be published. Thank you.
